LICENSED MEDICAL PRACTITIONER Part Time Position

Valley Mental Health is looking to contract with a prescriber to work with our Special Services clients who have both Developmental Disabilities and Mental Health Issues. This position is for one day per week.

Statement of Duties:

The licensed Medical Practitioner refers to people who meet the following minimum qualifications as documented by Valley Mental Health.

- ❖ Holds at least one of the following educational degrees and valid licensures:
 - Physician licensed to practice in the State of Oregon
 - Nurse Practitioner licensed to practice in the State of Oregon
- ❖ Possess training, experience and competence to conduct a comprehensive mental health assessment and provide medication management.

Examples of Duties:

Duties may include but are not limited to:

- . Completing comprehensive mental health assessments, medication management and follow up services
- . Reviewing Treatment Plans at minimum annually
- . Seeing clients face to face at minimum quarterly
- . Comfort working with indigent population with complex psychosocial backgrounds
- . Any of the services provided by a qualified mental health professional
- . Coordinating care with members of treatment team including therapists, case managers, primary care providers and other community members involved in client care
- . Detailed documentation of all treatment provided in compliance with Medicaid standards and Oregon Administrative Rules
- . After Hours coverage
- . Performs other duties as required.

This specific position also includes the following:

- . Comfort working with persons with developmental and intellectual disabilities
- . Ability to coordinate effectively with group home providers and the DD case workers

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Effective and consistent communication skills with clients, co-workers and other team members.

Knowledge of principles and practices of Medicaid and Medicare rules.

Timely and accurate completion of treatment plans, assessments, progress notes and termination forms.

Must be able to work autonomously.
